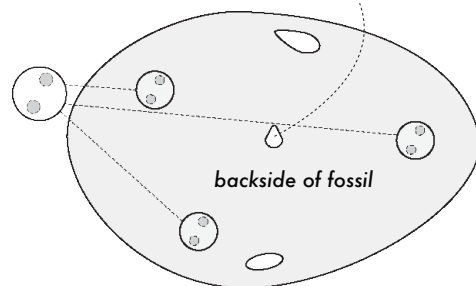

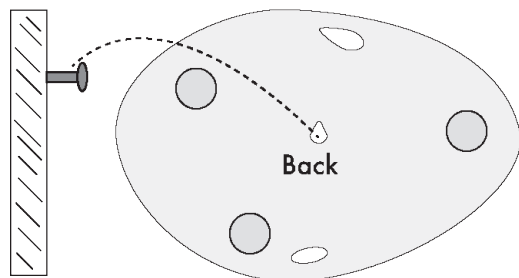
Stick the 3 wall supports on the **backside** of the fossil. These will keep the fossil 'floating' on your wall when installed.

This hole is for hanging the fossil on a nail or screw in the wall



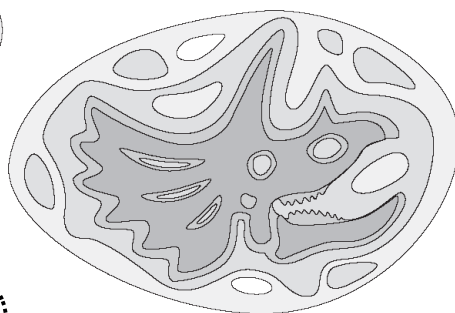

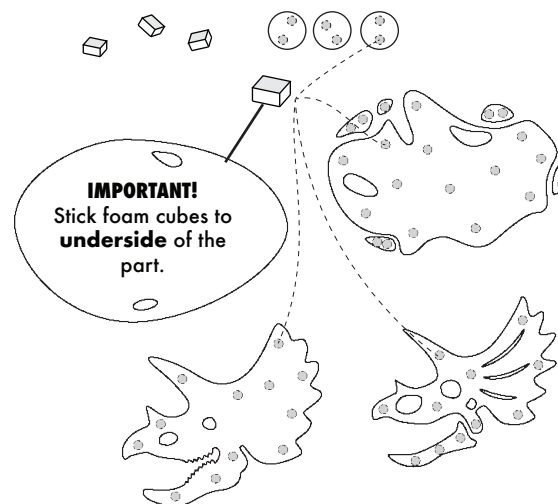


Clean hands in this stage will be very convenient for a nice final result!

Flip the layers **upside down** & stick 3D foam cubes under each part but **leave the non-stick film** on the other side of the cubes still on (for now).

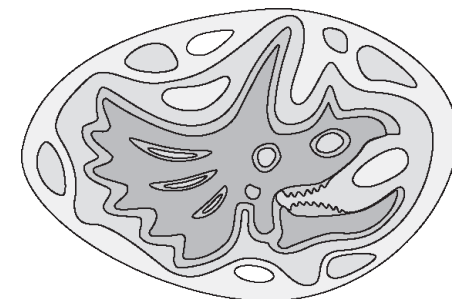


IMPORTANT!
Stick foam cubes to **underside** of the part.

Arrange all layers like illustrated below to make the correct composition.

Follow up by sticking all parts in the right position.



Important! The cardboard and paper parts are fragile! Please work carefully, don't squeeze or force the parts. The illustrations will lead you through the process.

Lasercut cardboard edges make your hands a little dirty. Especially with the neon and white cardboard its recommended to clean your hands occasionally during the build and try not to touch the neon as much as possible for a nice and clean final result.



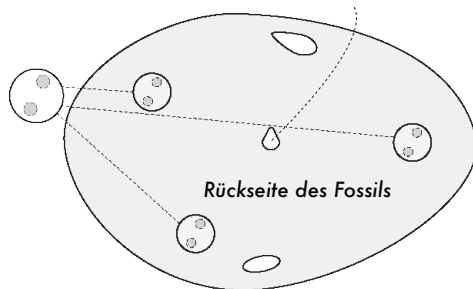
