Important! The cardboard and paper parts are fragile so please work carefully. Start with building the cardboard skeleton frame. The illustrations will lead you through the process.



For inserting a skewer to make a standing display



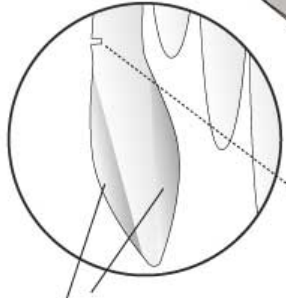
For hanging on a nail in the wall



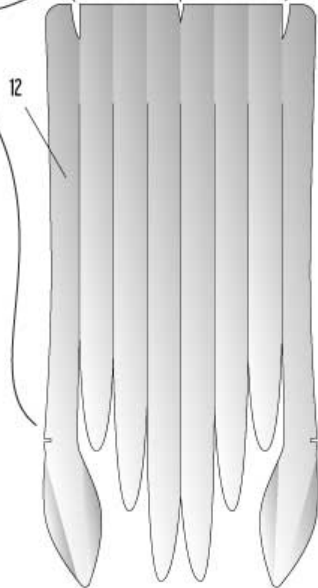

When handling the metallic paper parts, clean hands will be best for a nice final result



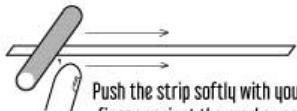
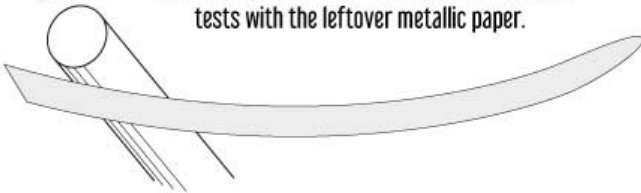
light bend downwards



Curling the arms / tentacles

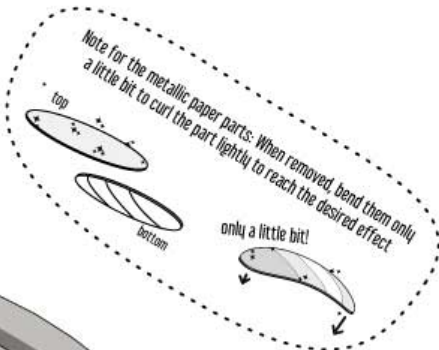
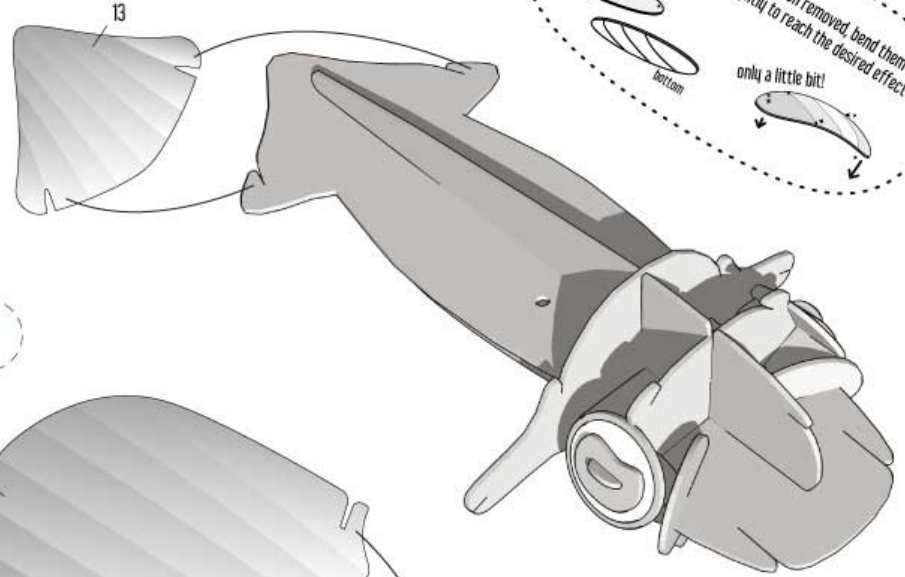
For curling the squid arms and tentacles, use a round smooth object like a big permanent marker or something similar. A regular pen is a bit too thin to make a nice curl without making wrinkles. Make tests with the leftover metallic paper.

Ø +15mm



Push the strip softly with your finger against the marker and slide along the strip to make it curl a little bit.
