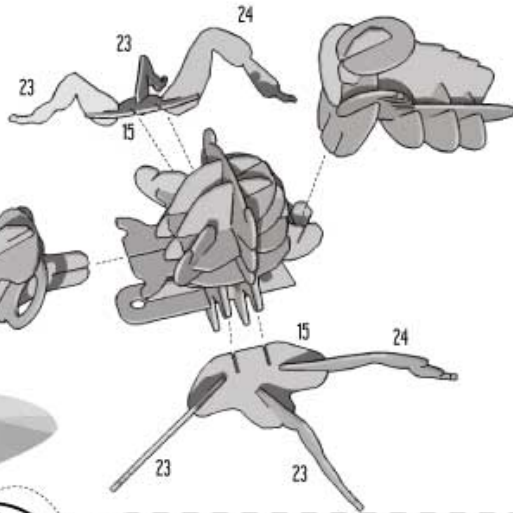
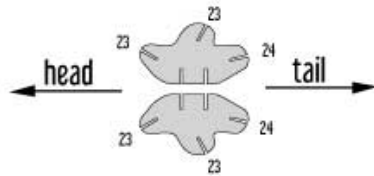
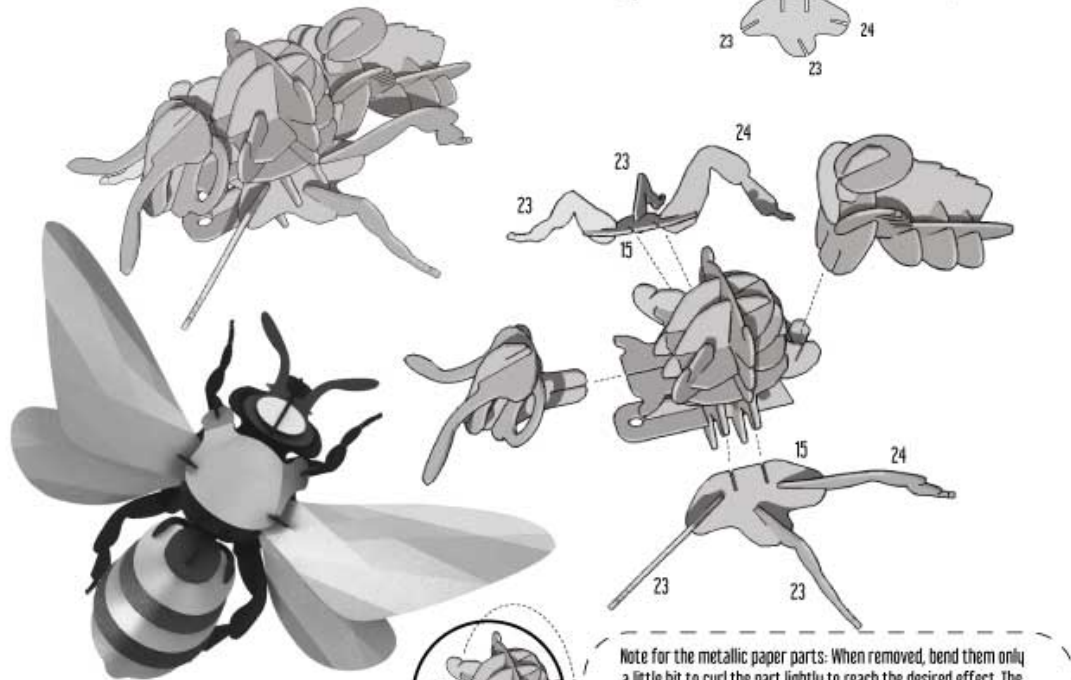


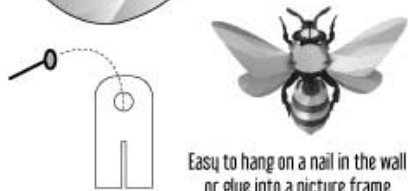
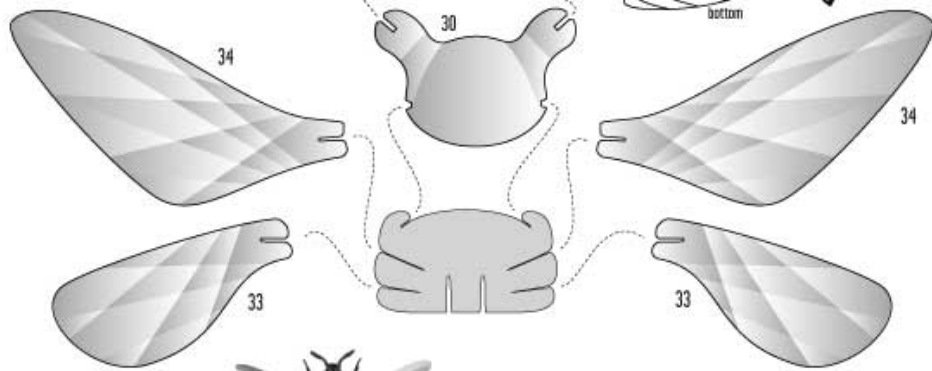
4 Connect head, tail and legs to the body

When handling the metallic paper parts, clean hands will be best for a nice final result.

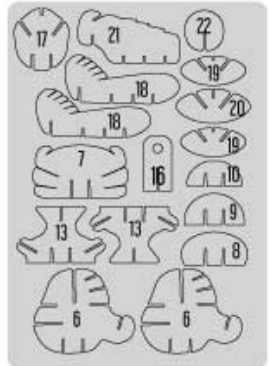

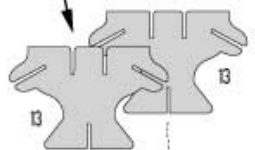


Now time to think of how you would like to present your big bee. On the wall / picture frame or standing on your desk/shelf. Follow the steps needed for the option of your choice.

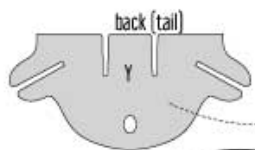
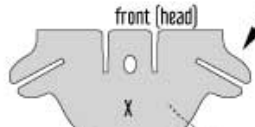
